Nancy works as a consultant in Australia with the Coalition for Epidemic Preparedness Innovations (CEPI). She is currently on sabbatical from the Wellcome Trust, the world's second largest research charity based in the UK, where she was the Global Policy Lead, jointly managing Wellcome's Global Health Policy Team. Nancy has over ten years experience in policy and advocacy issues in the UK and the EU, more recently covering global policy work. She was the policy lead in establishing the Wellcome strategic priority areas of Vaccines and Drug Resistant Infection. Nancy was also the Wellcome lead in the establishment of CEPI in 2016, during which time she worked closely with partners in Norway, India, the World Economic Forum (WEF), the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, WHO and others across industry and academia. She has represented Wellcome at various global fora, including meetings at the UN General Assembly, World Economic Forum, and the World Health Assembly.
